

## **DIVISION 2. LEGISLATIVE, FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE**

### **Sec. 2-101. Created.**

There is hereby created a legislative, finance, and administration committee.

### **Sec. 2-102. Members.**

- (a) *Composition; selection; terms.* The legislative, finance, and administration committee shall be composed of five members, four of which are appointed by the council president and one appointed by the committee chairperson, with all appointments subject to confirmation of a voting majority of the city council. Three of the members shall be elected city officials, and the two remaining members shall be city residents. The members of the committee shall serve one-year terms unless sooner removed.
- (b) *Removal.* A member of such committee shall be removable by a three-fourths vote of the city council, excluding any councilmember under consideration, after written notice shall have been given the member being considered for removal, at a reasonable time prior to the proceeding, stating the time, place and date of the removal proceeding.

### **Sec. 2-103. Functions.**

The legislative, finance, and administration committee shall advise the city council on proposed Charter amendments, ordinances to be adopted or amended, and other legislative matters; and shall advise the city council on financial matters, including the city's budget, assessments, and taxation; and advise the city council on administrative issues, policy, procedures, and operations of the city. The legislative, finance, and administration committee shall act as an advisory committee to the city council regarding matters relating to the mayor, council, city manager's office, finance department, administrative services, city clerk's office, tax assessor's office, human resources department, central services department, information technology department, election board, pension boards, and any omitted or new departments or committees, and other areas as deemed appropriate.
