

DIVISION 4. SAFETY ADVISORY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

Sec. 2-141. Created.

There is hereby created a safety advisory and transportation committee.

Sec. 2-142. Members.

- (a) *Composition; appointment; terms.* The safety advisory and transportation committee shall be composed of five members, four of which are appointed by the council president and one appointed by the committee chairperson, with all appointments subject to confirmation of a voting majority of the city council. Three of the members shall be elected city officials, and the two remaining members shall be city residents. The members of the committee shall serve one-year terms unless sooner removed.
- (b) *Removal.* A member of such committee shall be removable by a three-fourths vote of the city council, excluding any councilmember under consideration, after written notice shall have been given the member being considered for removal, at a reasonable time prior to the proceeding, stating the time, place and date of the removal proceeding.

Sec. 2-143. Functions.

The safety advisory and transportation committee shall advise the city council on public safety issues, policies, procedures, and operations relative to emergency operations, and fire and police services. The safety advisory and transportation committee shall act as an advisory committee to the city council regarding matters relating to the police department, fire department, department of inspections, and other areas as deemed appropriate.
