Dear Mayor & Council:

Attached is the February 2004 report. The Robbins Hose Company responded to 60 incidents during this time.

During the month of February firefighters trained in Aerial Ladder Operations, Ice Water Rescue Operations, CPR and Rope Rescue techniques.

The incidents of the most interest during the month are the following:

1. 2234 Hazletville Rd. Firefighters responded to a motor vehicle collision involving a school bus. Firefighters extricated one person from the vehicle with the Jaws of Life.
2. Governors Ave. & Division St. Firefighters responded to a motor vehicle collision involving two vehicles. Firefighters extricated two patients from one vehicle using the Jaws of Life.
3. 297 College Rd. Firefighters responded to a reported house fire, before units arrived on location one person jumped from a second floor window but sustained no injuries the residence was heavily involved with fire. Forty-Two Dover firefighters responded containing the fire to the garage and rear of the home.
4. 70 Edgewood Rd. Firefighters responded to a reported house fire with one person reported trapped inside. Firefighters arrived on location with the residence heavily involved with fire, after searching the home the occupant was found with a neighbor. Fifty Dover firefighters contained the fire to the home of origin.
