



VOLUNTARY WATER CONSERVATION JULY 30, 2020

Dear Valued City of Dover Residents,

Due to a combination of the operational improvements at the Water Treatment Plant, high water demand and recent weather conditions, the City of Dover is requesting customers to conserve water usage. This voluntary water conservation request, effective immediately, will allow the City to increase their water reserve to handle any potential emergencies. Please utilize the following recommendations:

- Lawn and Turf Watering: Use of City supplied water for lawns and turf should be minimized and performed in a conservative manner. This should be accomplished between the hours of 5pm-9am.
- Landscape Plant Watering: Use of City supplied water for outdoor landscape plants (including groundcover, flowers, shrubs and trees) should be minimized and performed in a conservative manner. This should be accomplished between the hours of 5pm-9am.
- Washing Vehicles: Use of City supplied water for cleaning or washing vehicles should be minimized and performed in a conservative manner. This should be accomplished between the hours of 5pm-9am.

The City appreciates your cooperation with this matter. Every effort to conserve water is valuable.
