Small businesses may qualify for utility bill deferment.

Funds are limited to a first come first served basis and must be repaid in full at 0% interest by January 11, 2023.

Qualifying Businesses Must:

- Be a viable business with a current City of Dover and State of Delaware business license.
- Must have been current with utility bills on March 1, 2020.
- Have not been subject to disconnection for non-payment more than once from March 1, 2019 through February 29, 2020.
- Must demonstrate proof of COVID-19 impact as determined by the County, State, or Federal Government.
- Must be a small business with 35 employees or fewer.
- Must have a physical location of operation and be a commercial customer within the City of Dover utility service area and fall within the electric rate classes—C, C1, C2, C3, & C5.
- Must have had all property tax and other tax payments current as of March 1, 2020.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING JANUARY 11, 2021 - OCTOBER 31, 2021
