Meter Tampering

It is <u>UNLAWFUL</u> for any person, except a duly authorized representative of the City, to make any temporary or permanent connection or disconnection between the electric service load of the customer and electric service wire of the City.

TAMPERING is to set, change, damage, remove or interfere with or make any connection to the City's meter or other property or any wiring between the City's meter and the electric service wires of the City.

- In the event that the City's meters or other property are tampered or interfered with, the customer being supplied through that equipment will:
 - Pay the amount which the City will estimate is due for electric service, both metered and/or un-metered (if applicable).
 - Pay for any testing, repairs or replacements required, for damaged or missing equipment.
 - Pay any service charges for any involved departments.
 - Pay for any changes in the customer's installation that the City will require.
- The customer is subject to arrest for tampering and/or theft of service.
- Before service can be RE-ENERGIZED, all repairs must be made and a State Licensed Safety inspections obtained.
 - <u>FULL PAYMENT</u> for all monies owed the City must be made, including any additional SECURITY DEPOSIT that may be required.
- In cases where it cannot be determined who was being supplied, the <u>owner of the</u> property may be held responsible for the tampering/theft.
