NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IN COUNCIL MET, that the map attached hereto is hereby adopted as the official map of the City of Dover which shall be recorded at the Office of the Kent County Recorder of Deeds.

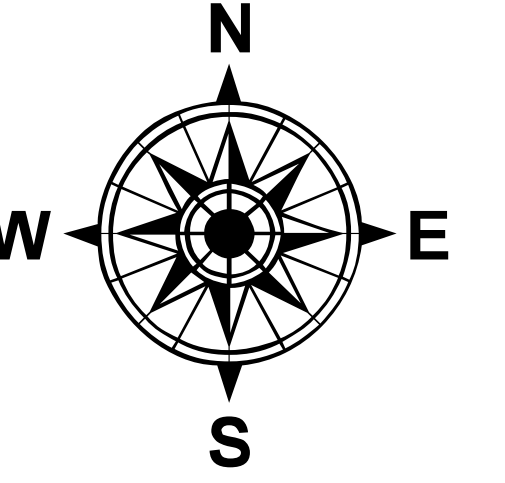
