## **Silver Lake Draw Down Dover, Delaware**

The City of Dover, with a recommendation from the Silver Lake Commission, will be performing a draw down of Silver Lake beginning **Monday, October 10, 2022 through Friday, October 21, 2022**. All efforts will be put forth to ensure the fish and other water species are not harmed in any manner during this short draw down period.

This is a scheduled draw down and the city wants to make residents aware as not to cause alarm should they notice the lake water level changing. This will be an opportunity for lake-side residents to clean up debris and other items on their property.

The draw down is weather dependent. If there are periods of precipitation during the time of the draw down, it is likely the water level will not have notable change.

The Silver Lake Commission is committed to improving Silver Lake Park and Lake waterways. This is just one of many steps that are taken throughout the year to support that commitment.
