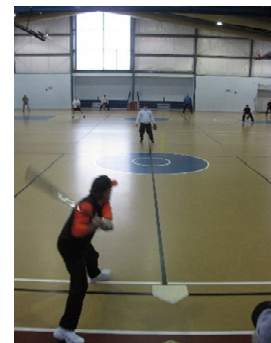

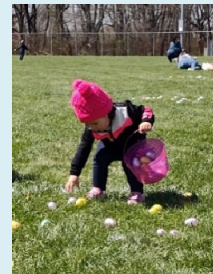
ANNUAL EGG HUNT

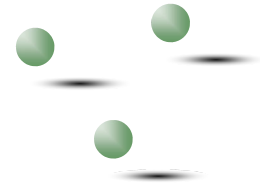
