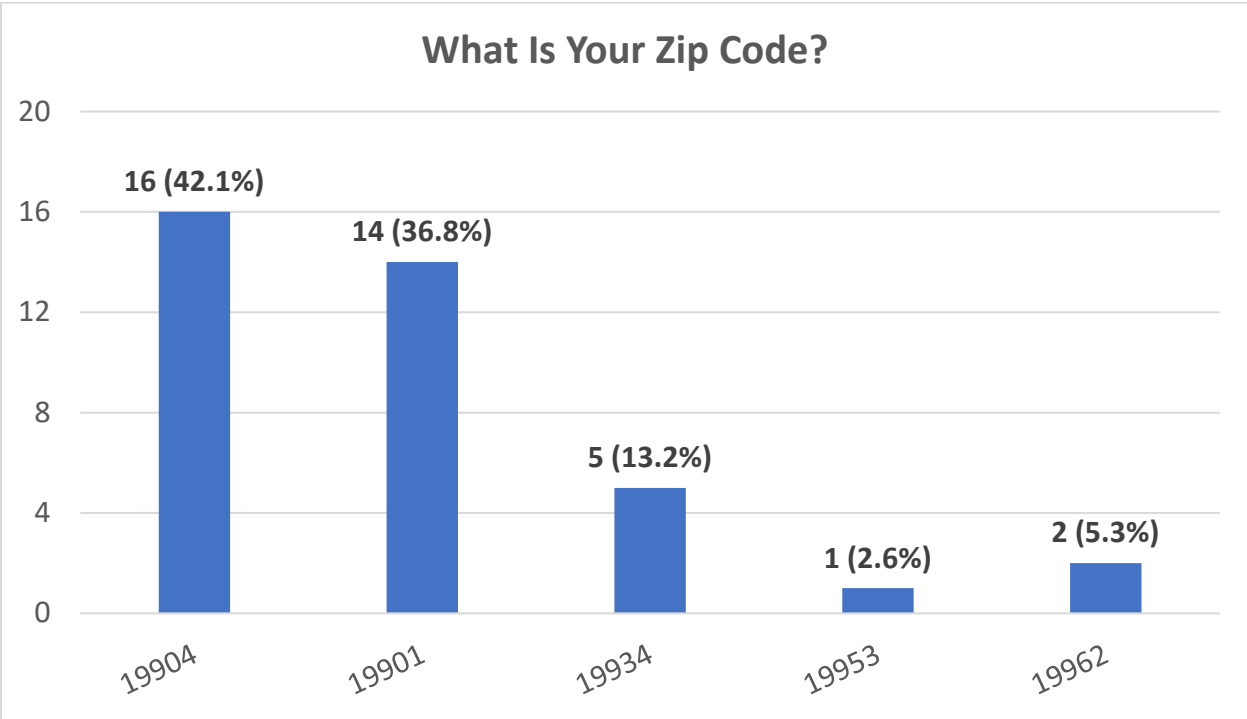


Dover Park Survey Results

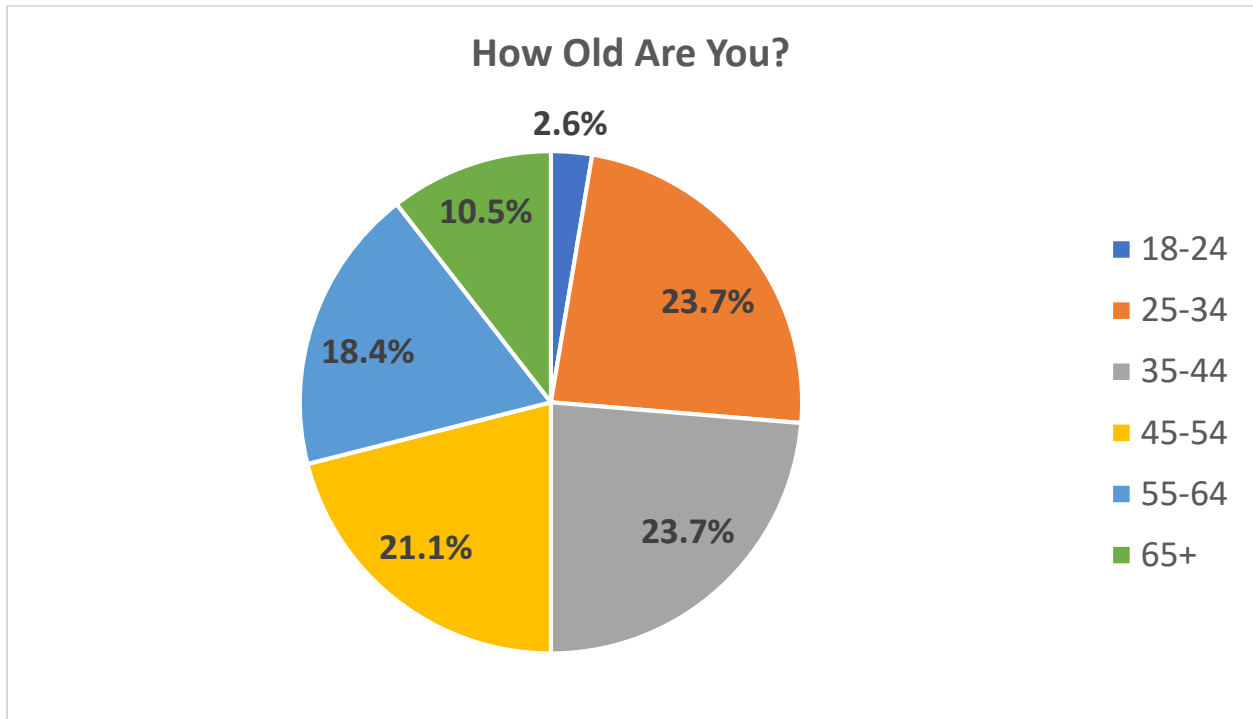
The Dover Park Survey was posted on the City website from September 11 to October 9. The City received 38 responses.

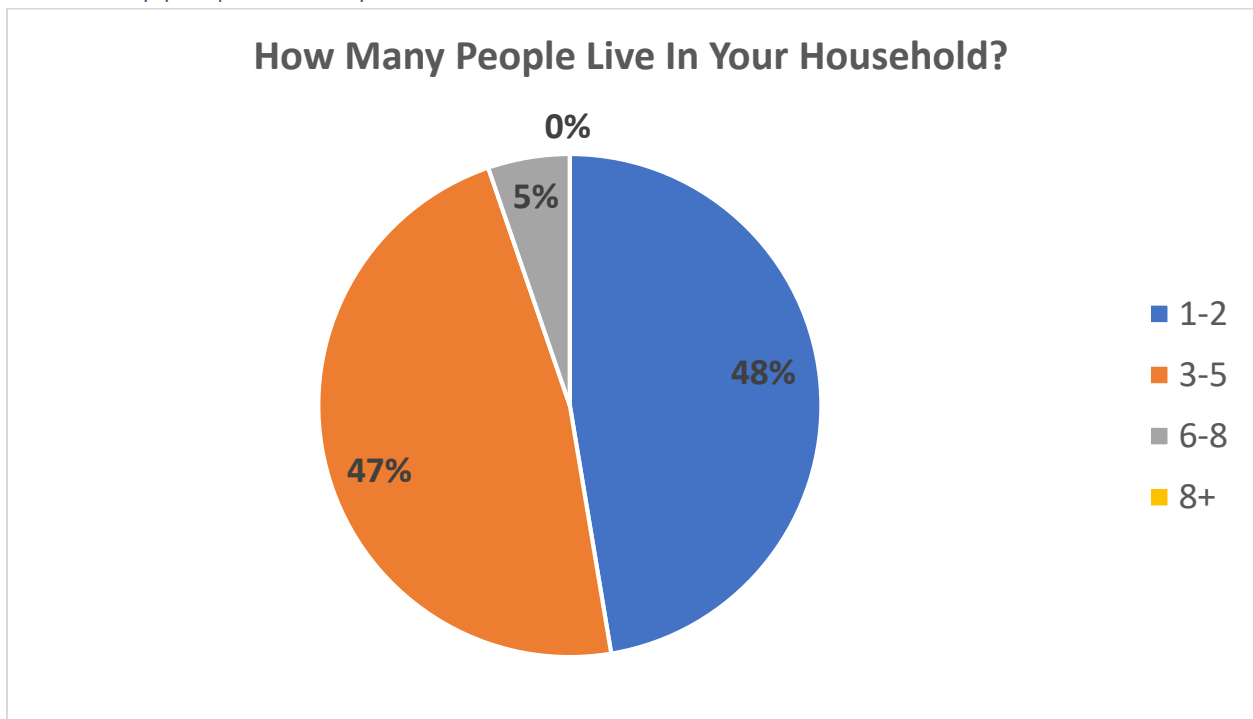
What is your zip code?



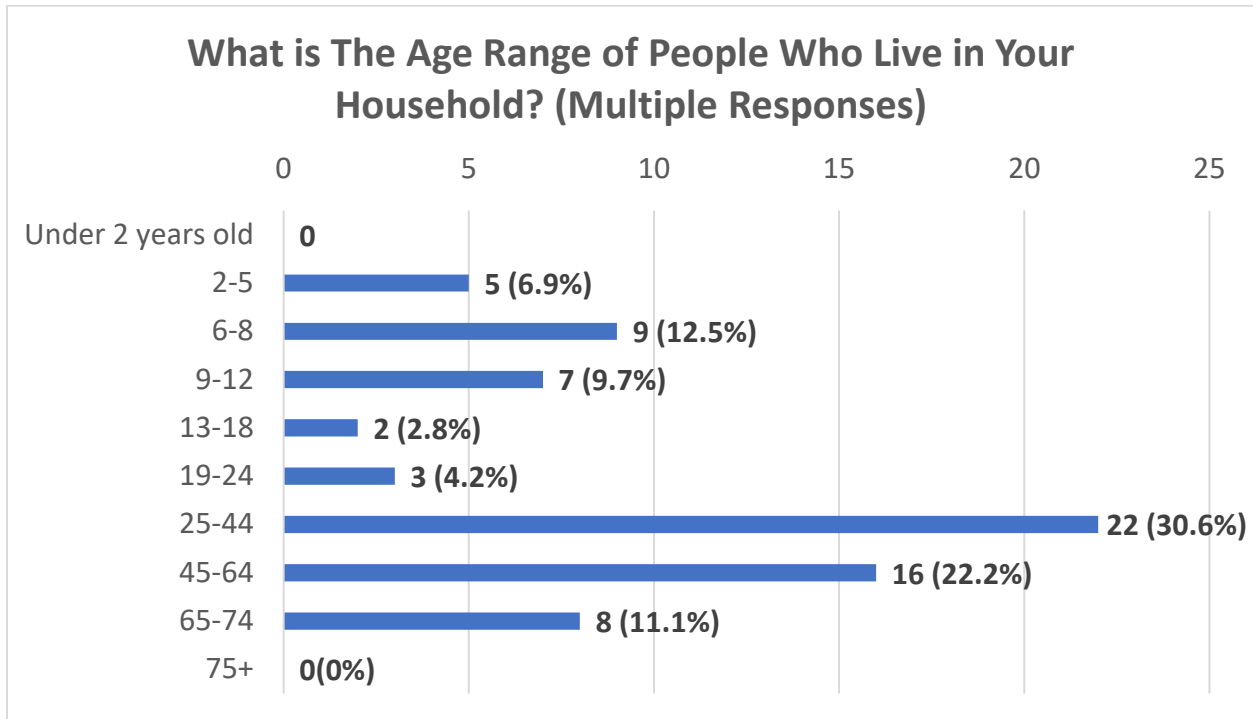
How old are you?



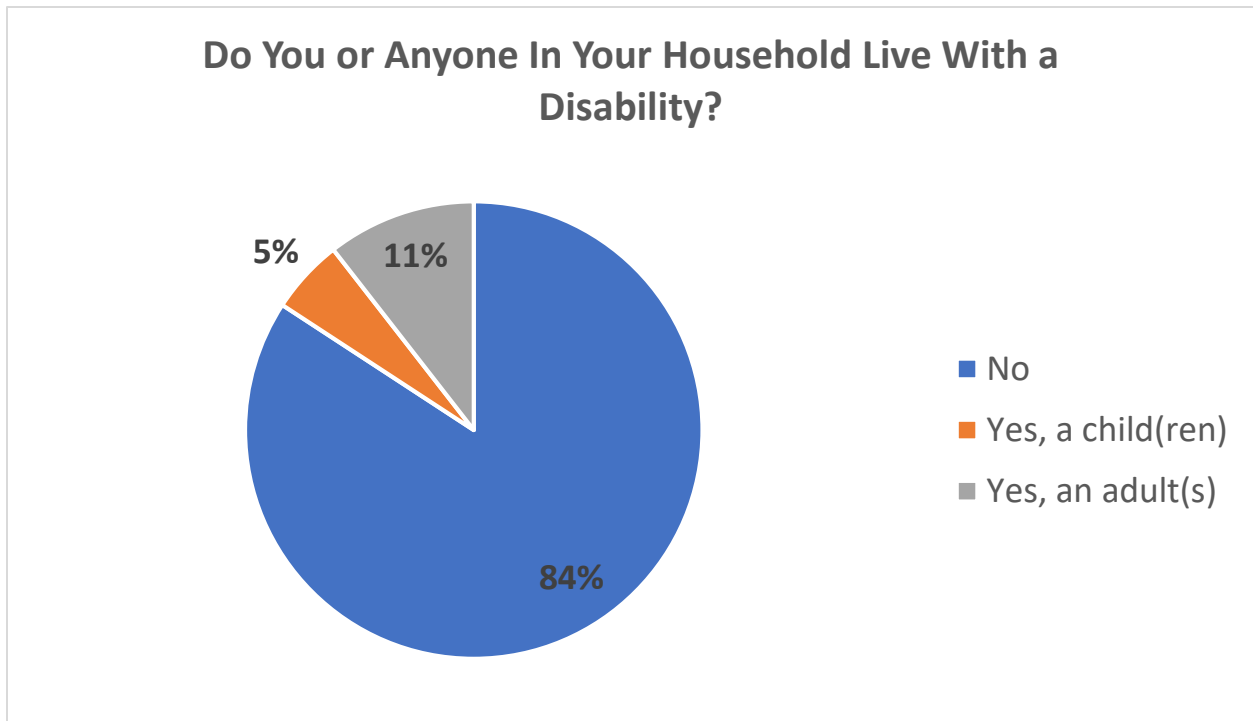
How many people live in your household?



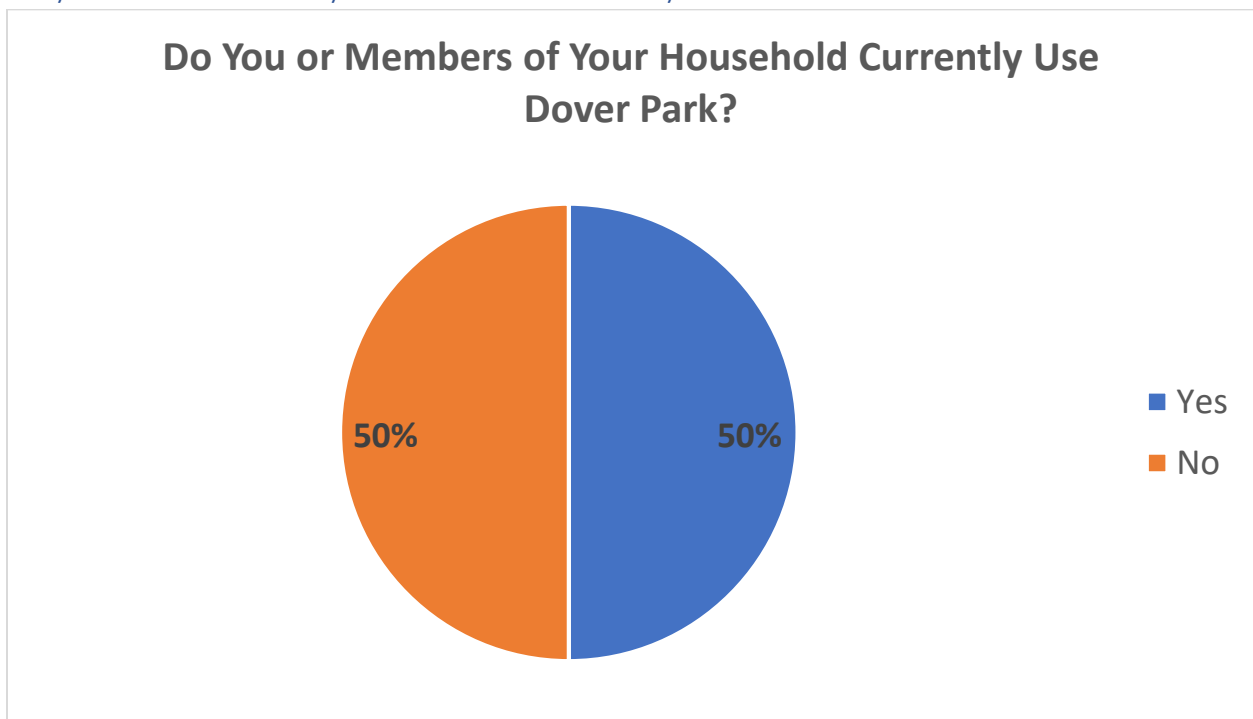
What is the age range of people who live in your household?



Do you or anyone in your household live with a disability?

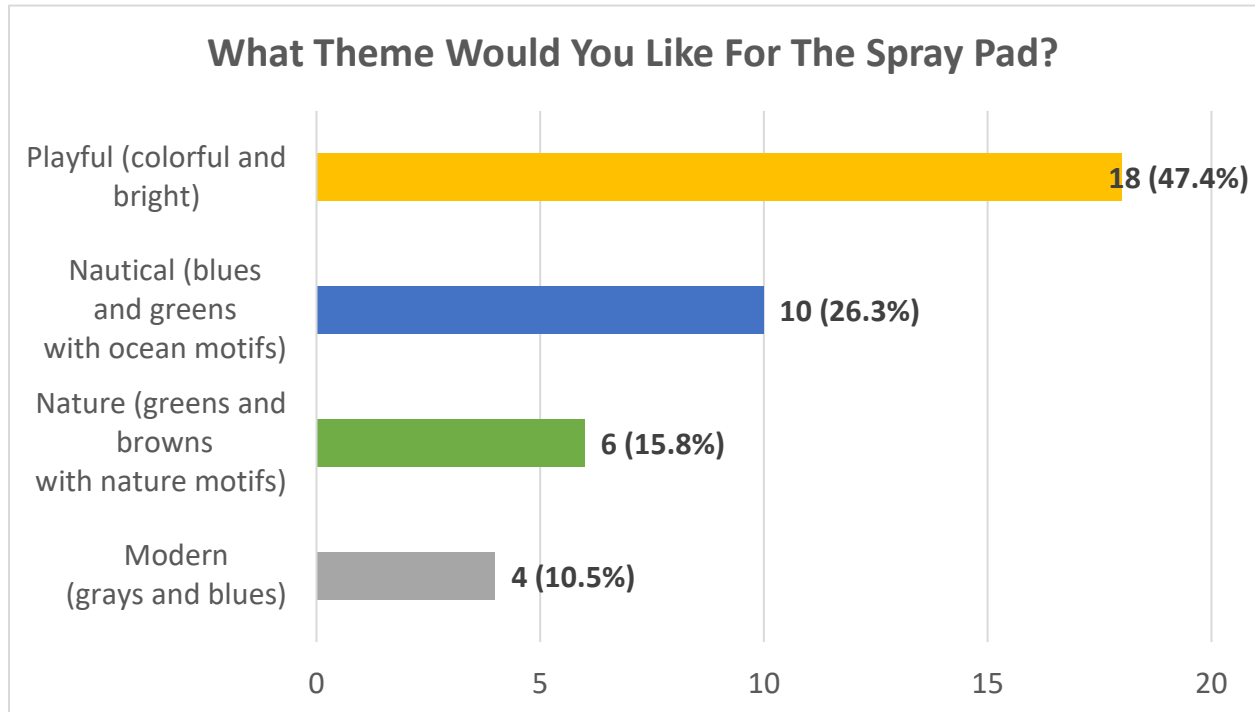


Do you or members of your household currently use Dover Park?

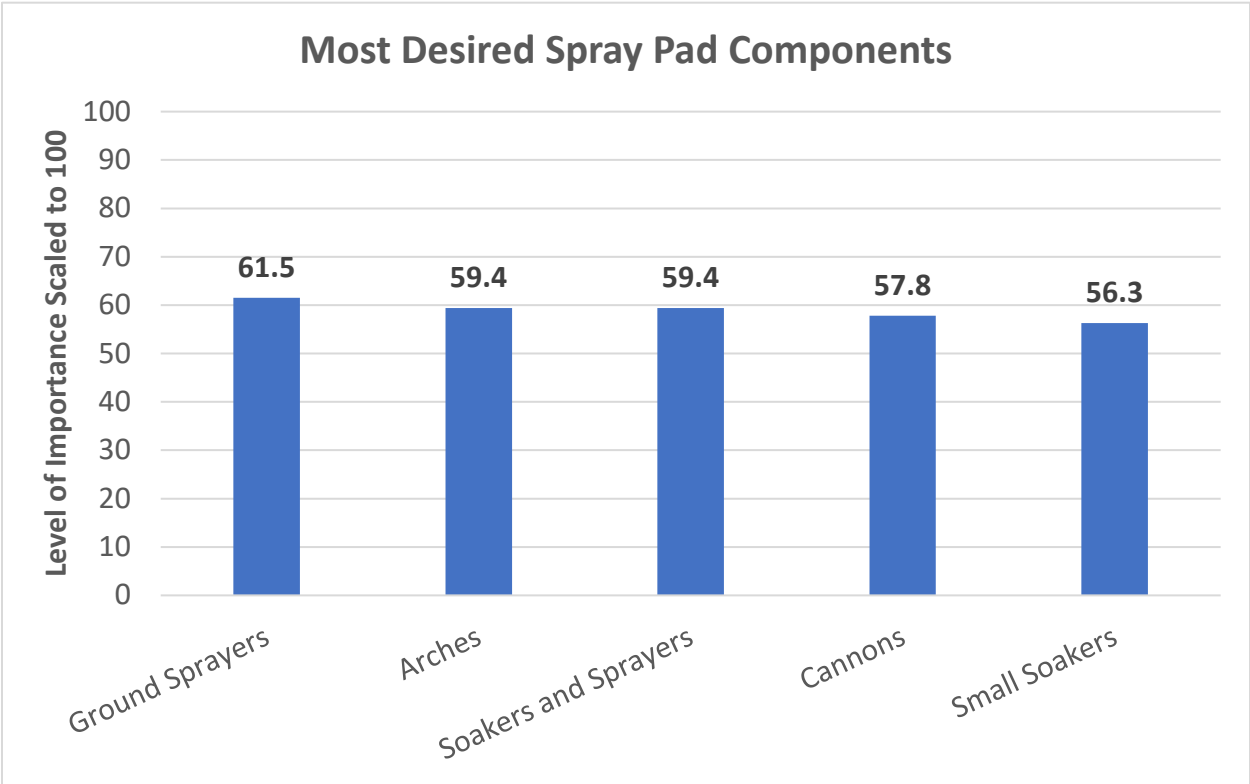


Spray Pad

What theme would you like for the spray pad?

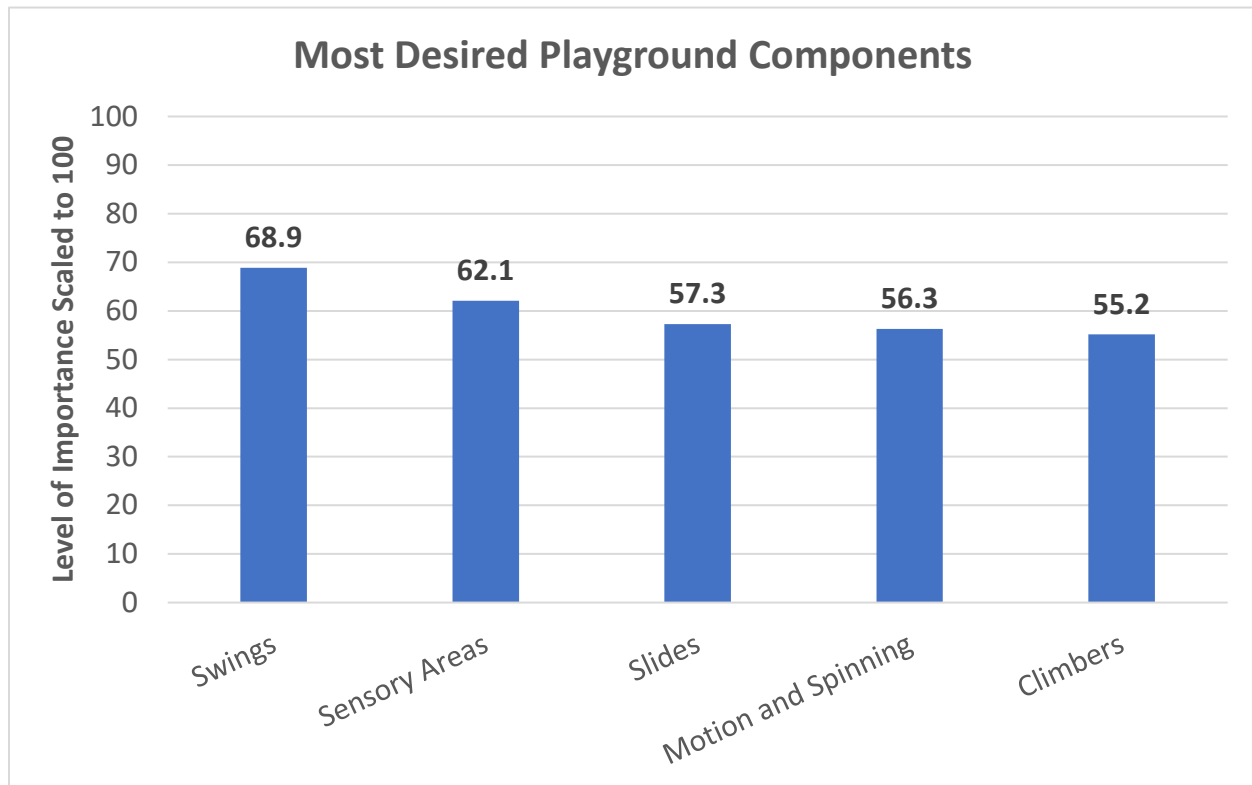


What water features do you desire the most for the spray pad?



Accessible Playground

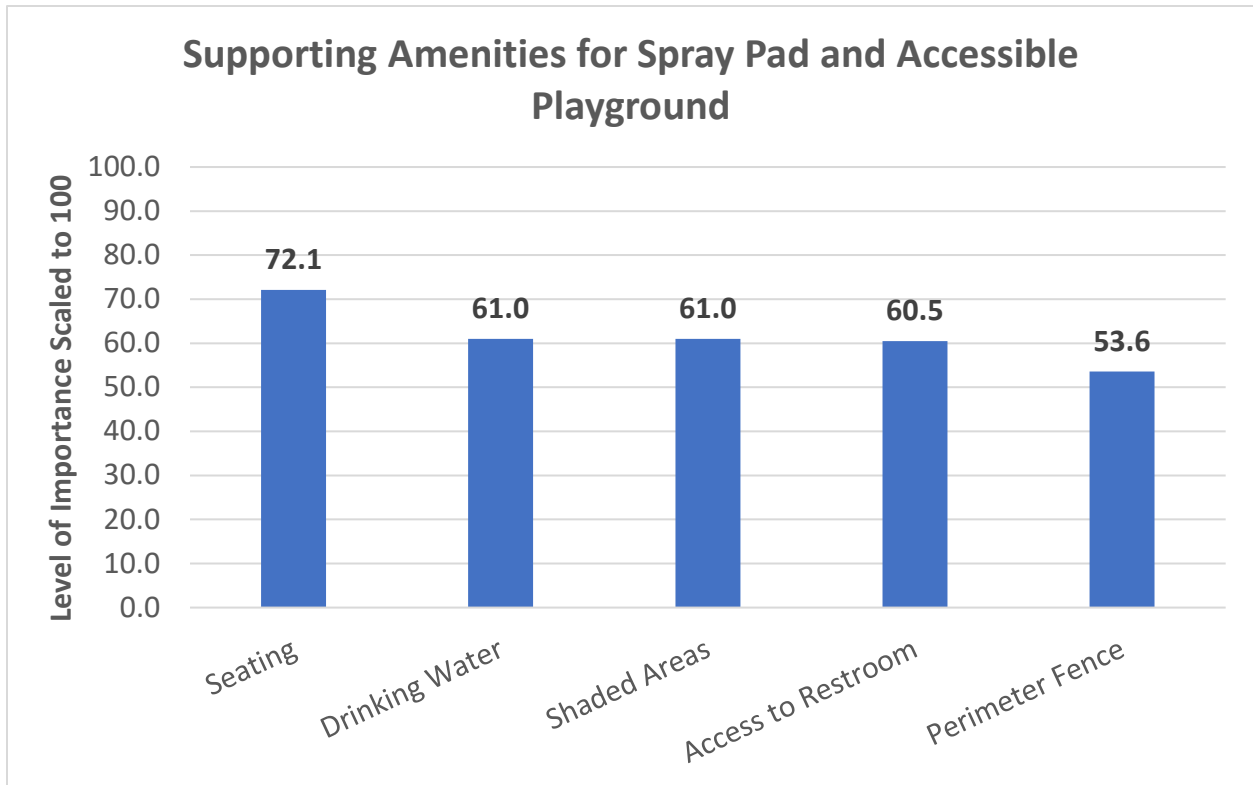

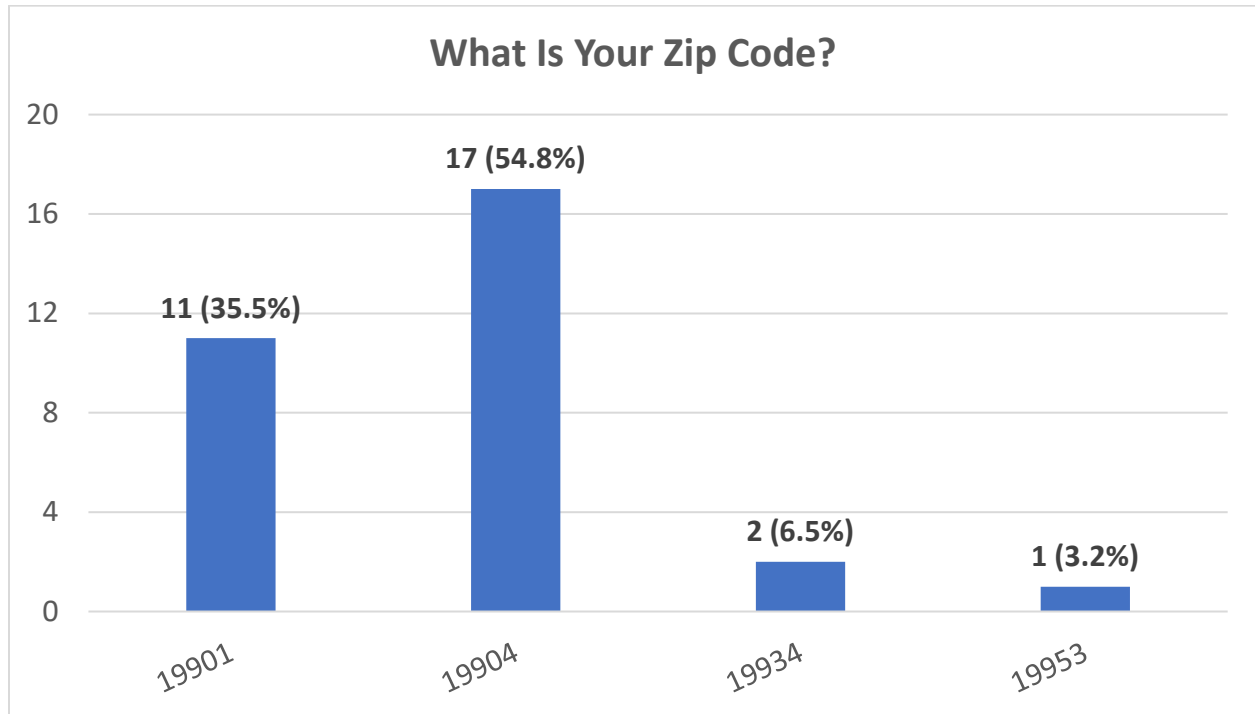

- Proper lighting

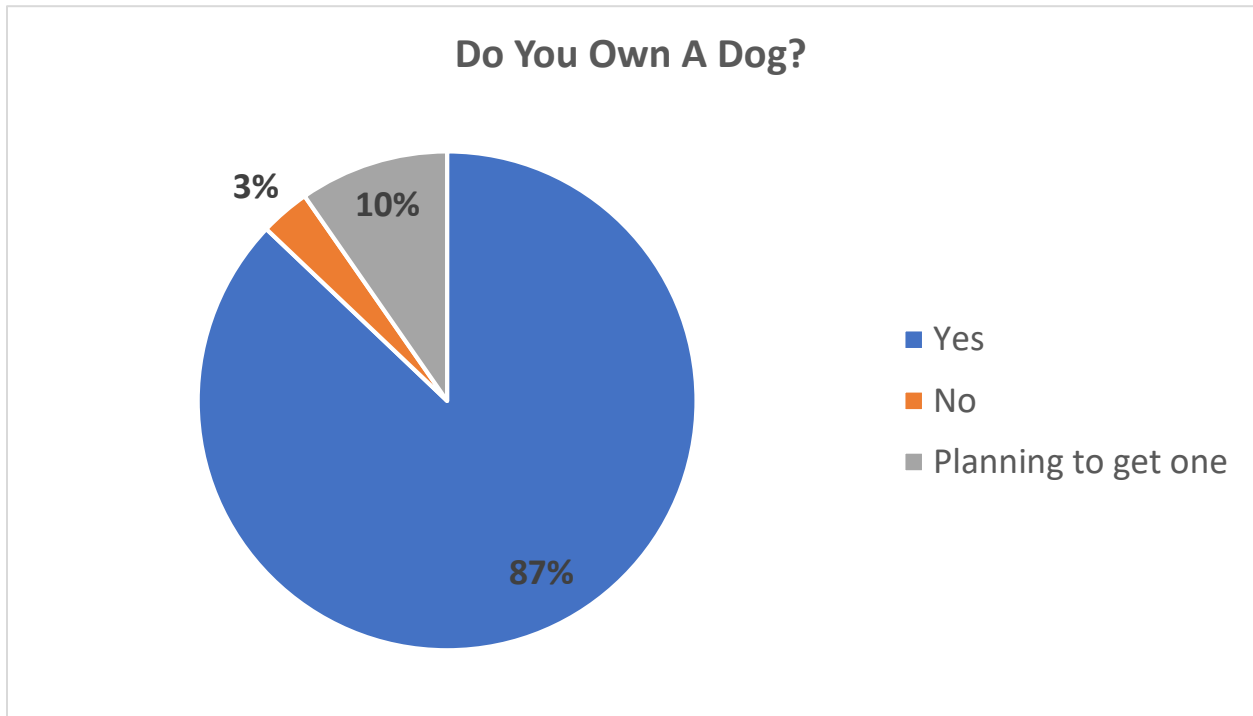

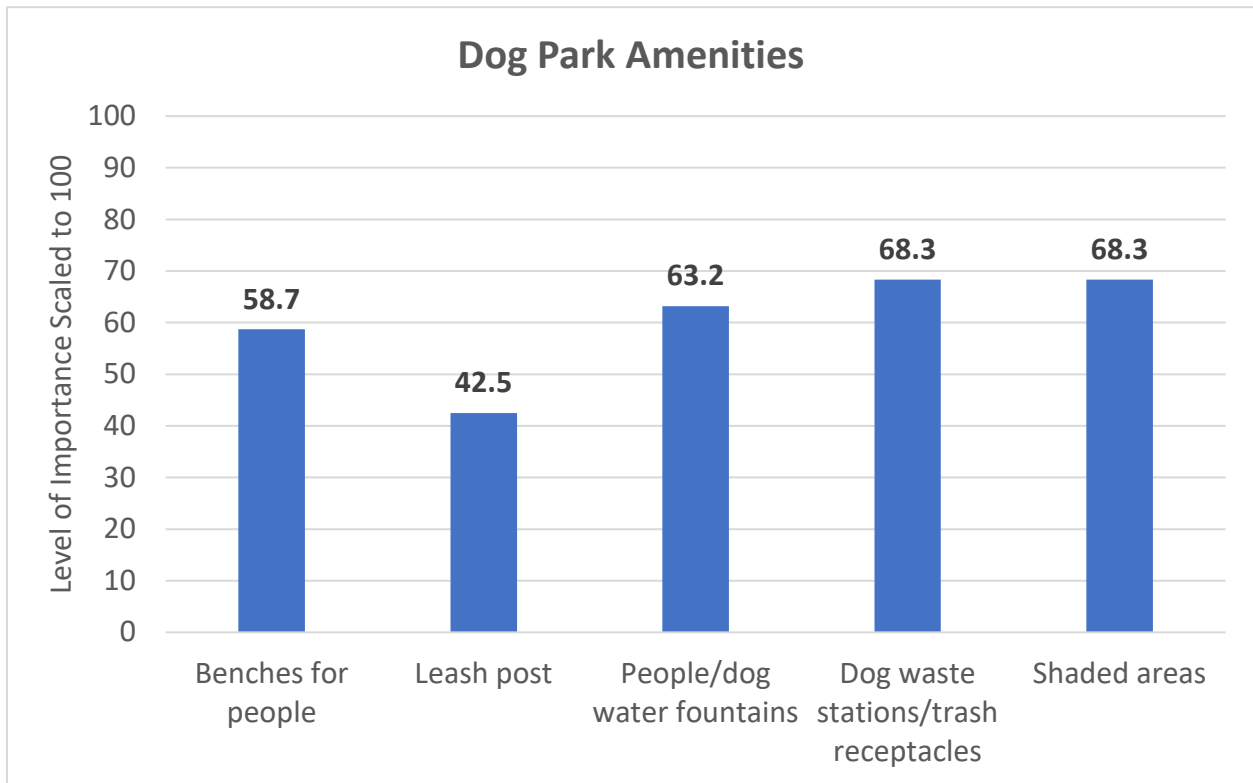
