






- Co-creation process involving skatepark users













SKATEABLE ART


3 respondents requested skateable art be added to the park's design.

GREAT FEATURES

Respondents were most concerned with regular features as opposed to features that are unique to the local community. 12 respondents answered by advocating generic features.

ENLIST LOCAL ARTISTS

10 respondents emphasized their interest in enlisting local artists to enhance the park.

SHAWN SHANNON MEMORIAL

7 respondents asked that local skate legend Shawn Shannon be memorialized in some way at the park.


