

SOLAR PANEL REQUIREMENTS

A building permit is required for

Solar Panel Installations.

1– Two copies of manufacturer specifications and drawings are required to be submitted with the permit as well as an engineer's report. The required information is to confirm the number of layers on the roof (A maximum of two layers is permitted by code.), fastening requirements, and an engineered report confirming that the roof will support all intended loads. Design criteria are to include but not limited to, the layer(s) of shingles + solar panels + snow load. Permit requirements may vary for buildings located within the Historic District.

2– If an in ground installation is proposed, a building permit and plot plan are required confirming location on the lot and coverage. Two copies of drawings, plot plan and manufacturer's specifications are required. Plans are to confirm footings / foundation requirements.

3- All installations will require third party electrical approval and may be subject to metering / disconnect requirements by the utility having jurisdiction.

Standard building permit fees apply.

City of Dover Inspections may include and not limited to:

Electrical (3rd party) Framing (if applicable) Footing (if applicable) Final Inspection (always)

NOTES:

FOLLOW MANUFACTURER SPECIFICATION and INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS ALL INSTALLATIONS REQUIRE 3RD PARTY ELECTRICAL APPROVAL.
