How can you help?
Follow these simple tips
to help keep our water clean.

- Never dump anything down a storm drain
- Keep grass clippings off sidewalks and streets
- Use fertilizers and pesticides sparingly and sweep up excess
- Check your car for leaks, and recycle used motor oil
- Take your car to a carwash instead of washing it in the driveway
- Pick up after your pet
- Compost your yard waste
