



EMERGENCY STREET REPAIR LOTUS STREET

JANUARY 30, 2018 - UPDATE

Dear Valued City of Dover Residents,

On January 13, 2018 the City of Dover received complaints regarding the pavement condition on Lotus Street, specifically west of Orchard Avenue. City staff tried to address the road conditions, however, it was determined that the sub grade is not suitable to sustain traffic safely, which is causing the road section to disintegrate. The City has partnered with George and Lynch to repair approximately 250 linear feet of the street. **The work began on Thursday, January 25, 2018 and due to the inclement weather, is scheduled to conclude on February 1, 2018.** This work will be accomplished by utilizing a single lane closure, therefore, traffic can progress through this area. Trash collection in this area will occur normally. The City will try to provide access to driveways throughout the project, but cannot guarantee it will be open at all times. The City encourages the residents affected to utilize the alley access.
