Dear Valued City of Dover Customers,

On June 25, 2018 the Dover City Council awarded a contract to Gateway Construction, Inc. to replace the water main on your street. **The replacement project is scheduled to start on or around September 4, 2018 and is planned to conclude on or around October 4, 2018**, weather permitting. Additional correspondence will be delivered when a definitive start date is determined. This project will improve the quality of our water, improve available capacity, increase system reliability and make improvements for fire protection.

This replacement project will install a new larger water main as well as new water services (to the right-of-way), new curb stops and new water meters. Customers will be notified at least 48 hours prior to any scheduled water interruptions. During construction, temporary road closures may be required within the scope of the project, however, your trash removal will remain available throughout the entire project. Following the necessary installation work, disturbed areas within the road will be patched and blacktopped, as well as grassy areas that are disturbed will be re-seeded.

This project was initiated after staff was informed of a DelDOT traffic calming project on North State Street. Prior to the traffic calming project, staff identified the need for upgrading the existing four-inch (4") unlined cast iron water main located in North State Street, between Pennsylvania Avenue and Columbia Avenue. The existing water main will be replaced with a new twelve-inch (12") cement lined ductile iron water main. The existing undersized mains were installed around 1963. The new water mains will provide City of Dover customers with improved water quality, increased system reliability and improved fire protection.
