

City of Dover Residential Trash Collection Guidelines



Trash should be placed out for pickup on collection day by 7:00 a.m. or the prior evening after 7:00 p.m.

CAN PLACEMENT

<u>ALL</u> household trash <u>MUST</u> be bagged and placed in the 90-gallon container provided by the City (<u>NO</u> trash on top of cans). Please place container at least 3-feet away from cars, fences, mailboxes, etc., facing the correct direction (as seen in the photo below).



Too close together, too close to vehicle, and too close to mailbox.



Correct spacing and facing correct direction.

YARD WASTE

<u>ALL</u> loose yard waste material <u>MUST</u> be placed in a privately owned 35-gallon or less plastic container (limit 5 containers). Yard waste containers are picked up on the regular weekly schedule. Yard waste shall not be placed in a plastic or paper bag. Yard waste shall not be mixed with household trash; if mixed the City will not collect.





BULK WASTE

Bulk waste shall be neatly stacked at the curb. Do <u>NOT</u> place bulk piles directly under power lines or against buildings or fences. The maximum size shall be a **4'** wide, 4' tall, 8' long area.

Bulk yard waste consists of yard waste that will not fit within the 35-gallon container. Bulk yard waste is collected on the same day as your recycling collection.

Bulk household waste (furniture, large appliances, rugs, etc.) is collected on the week opposite your recycling collection.

SORRY, WE CANNOT COLLECT TIRES, CONCRETE, BRICKS, CHEMICALS OR OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE.
