

LEAD & COPPER RULE REVISIONS

Dear Valued City of Dover Residents,

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently announced that revisions to the current Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) for drinking water went into effect on December 16, 2021. All public water systems must comply with these LCR revisions by **October 16, 2024**.

The City of Dover has been in compliance with the LCR since its inception in 1991. We are committed to water quality and take these latest revisions seriously. We will be taking the appropriate and applicable steps to meet this 2024 deadline and stay in compliance with these LCR revisions to continue to provide our community with safe drinking water.
