
#### What is the Survey?

- ► Here is some of what we learned...




#### What have we learned from the Survey?


- We had 511 respondents!
- The graph at right shows the age mix of who participated




# We asked how respondents wanted to receive information

The City should work with Dover's institutions of higher education to promote the City as a center for higher education and encourage greater involvement of college students in the local economy.













Dover should prioritize the creation of more skilled labor and trade jobs to improve our economy and provide opportunities for our youth



The City should strengthen the Downtown by investing in key public facilities, such as a parking garage, new City Hall, and improvements to the downtown streetscape.



Recent large-scale investment in downtown Dover




Dover should actively promote tourism, the arts, recreation, cultural resources, natural resources, and entertainment as key components of maintaining a high quality of life.





The Schwartz Center, Dover


Several studies have proposed a major mixed-use redevelopment of the western end of Loockerman Street and the Forest Street gateway into the City. The City should implement these studies



There is an adequate supply of housing in Dover for people of all ages, family styles, and economic classes.












Opening of POW-MIA Parkway in Dover

The most requested improvement to DART was to have:


▶ 1<sup>st</sup>: Longer Bus hours




Filter Stormwater before it reaches Silver Lake

Prevent new development in known Flood areas


Plant more trees around the city

# Please rate how well new residential neighborhoods are designed and developed Weighted Average Score






Please rate how well new commercial and other non-residential construction is designed







The City of Dover should actively seek to retain the base within the City by enacting policies that support its mission. The City should oppose any efforts or activities that may result in a future base closure.
